High-quality in-season fruits like grapes, nectarines, pears, and plums are available with every meal. Options will vary for each meal pickup.



Meals will only be available to school-aged children, enrolled at an SCUSD school, associated charter school, or SCUSD child care program. Children not enrolled in school will not be eligible for meals.

Families must provide the "Enrollment Verification Letter to Obtain School Meals" when picking up meals. This letter will be directly mailed to all families and contains the student's name, ID number, and barcode. Each enrolled student will receive this letter printed on gold-colored paper. Students do not need to be present to receive meals. To pick up meals for multiple students, please present each student's letter. If you did not receive this letter in the mail, please bring a student ID card, student ID number, or other enrollment documents.

Meals should be picked up at a student's school of enrollment or school within the same region. If a family has multiple SCUSD students, meals may be picked up from the school where the majority of the students attend.

Students who qualify for free/reduced meals will receive breakfast and lunch at no charge.
