In our efforts to improve our communications to the community, we introduced ParentSquare last year. This program gives us unique features to ensure a faster outlet of information. We encourage all parents who have not done so already to register for an account. If you have already registered but are not receiving any emails, check your spam/junk folder to ensure that the emails are not being sent there. Here are just SOME benefits of ParentSquare:

- <u>Text Feature</u>: This allows you to receive a text notification indicating some new communication has been sent out. Never miss an important notice again!
- Messages: Direct messaging your student's teacher(s) with questions or concerns you
  may have.
- Attachments: Signing up for a ParentSquare account will allow you to view all attachments and photos in a communication post.
- **Sign-ups**: Be able to sign up for volunteer jobs or donations for the classroom and school events

#### **Carline Safety**
